

**RUGBY CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING FOR
SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT & NATURAL GAS PIPELINE
WEDNESDAY, MAY 19, 2010

Council Members present: Rheault, Jacobson, Bednarz, Hoffert, Hartl, and Wentz. Also present were Mayor Niewoehner, and City Auditor/Administrator Harmel. Absent were Council Members Brossart and Schneibel, and City Attorney Butz.

Mayor Niewoehner called the meeting to order at 7:30pm. Council members recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call of council members by Mayor Niewoehner

Motion by Jacobson to approve a special event permit for Jester's Lounge for GCS Races and the Pierce County Fair, pending the City Attorney's approval. Second by Hartl, all voting yes, motion carried.

Kurt Rushmore from Major Pipeline presented information such as the cost, time and process regarding the possibility of bringing natural gas to the City of Rugby. A lengthy question and answer session with the council and members of the public was held. The possibility exists for the City to own the natural gas utility. Dave Blair and Bob Velue from Kadrmass, Lee, and Jackson were also present to answer questions and provide information.

Motion by Jacobson to approve signing a non-binding Letter of Intent to explore the feasibility and cost ratios of a natural gas project. Second by Bednarz. Roll call vote: Rheault - yes, Hartl - no, Bednarz - yes, Hoffert - yes, Wentz - yes, Jacobson - yes. Motion carried.

There being no further business to transact or to come before the Council at this time, Mayor Niewoehner adjourned the meeting at 8:59pm.
